

ACCREDITED SHOW

The 2015 Derbyshire County Show has been officially approved by DEFRA for the holding of an Accredited Show as required under Article 21 of the Brucellosis (England and Wales) Order 1981.

Veterinary Cover: A member of the Scarsdale Veterinary Group will be available on site throughout the Show. The Vet/s will be situated in a marquee next to the General Secretary's Marquee which is adjacent to the Members Marquee.

S.A.C. SHEEP HEALTH (MAEDI - VISNA) SCHEME

In accordance with the rules of the Sheep and Goat Health Schemes, there will be separate penning sections and sheep parking areas for M.V. accredited and non-accredited sheep. Separate transport to and from the Show will be required for M.V. accredited and non-accredited sheep. MV qualifying stock may not attend as accredited animals.

Entry forms must state clearly which section sheep are to be shown in and M.V. accredited sheep must be accompanied by a valid certificate of status (only the green SAC form is acceptable), which should be handed to the Chief Sheep Steward on arrival before sheep are unloaded. **N.B. Sheep will NOT be allowed to enter the M.V. accredited section without production of the certificate.** Separate penning will be available on the Showground for the two sections. Sheep from both sections may be shown in the Ring at the same time led on a halter but a minimum 2 metre separation must be maintained between Accredited and non-Accredited sheep.

No colouring matter, dressing, bleaching or chemical agent (except use of a DEFRA approved dip and the use of colourless oil on the head) may be used on sheep entered in these classes. All sheep entered are subject to the DEFRA Sheep Dipping Law.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED, ON VETERINARY ADVICE, TO BRING SUITABLE COVERS TO PROVIDE SHELTER FOR HOT OR WET WEATHER FOR THEIR SHEEP DURING THEIR STAY AT THE SHOW AS MARQUEES ARE NOT PROVIDED.

DEFRA Scrapie Scheme: Exhibitors with scrapie monitored flocks who wish to exhibit in lamb or newly lambed ewes are advised to consult their DVO for advice.

N.B. Sheep exhibited will be subject to veterinary inspection and any found suffering from infectious diseases will be removed.
