Tables and back screens will be draped in green cloth.
Backboards are NOT allowed with your exhibit.
Only tags/labels supplied to be used on the item or display and no identification of either entrant/s or WI.
All entries must be the bone-fide work of the exhibitor/s and must have been finished in the last year.
The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence entered into.
The marquee will close at 12 noon prompt for judging.
All flowers/floral exhibits to be brought pre-arranged.
The Board of Trustees cannot accept responsibility for any items entered and suggest that any valuable items be adequately insured by the exhibitor.
Fees are stated on the individual entry forms.
Check that your entry complies with the rules and information.

HOME ECONOMICS OPEN CLASSES

- Class 1 Jar of Lemon Curd
Tip for this class – Jar must be covered with a wax disc and a cellophane cover only. Please do not use commercial jars.
- Class 2 3 Red Jam Tarts - displayed on plate up to 8"/20cm
- Class 3 Marmalade Cake - to given recipe – see next page
- Class 4 Caterpillar Cake – decoration only to be judged
- Class 5 5 Red Velvet Cup Cakes – to given recipe, see next page
- Class 6 Flowers in a Teapot - not to exceed 12"/30.5cm in height
- Class 7 **Men’s Class** Mad Hatter Pizza – 8"/20cm displayed on a board
- Class 8 **Children’s Class under 7 years of age** – 1 Cheshire Cat Cup Cake – decoration only to be judged
- Class 9 **Young People’s Class 7-11 years** – 3 Heart Shaped Biscuits, undecorated - displayed on plate up to 8"/20cm
- Class 10 **Young People’s Class 12-16 years** – 3 decorated Queen of Hearts Shortbread Biscuits

RECIPE FOR RED VELVET CUP CAKES

Ingredients for the Cup Cakes

100g butter - softened 150g caster sugar, 125g self raising flour,
25g cocoa powder - sifted plus extra for dusting, 2 eggs,
2 tbsp milk, 10ml red natural food colouring gel

Ingredients for the Frosting

50g butter – softened, 200g full fat cream cheese, 300g icing sugar –
sifted, ½ tsp vanilla extract

Method

1. Preheat oven to 180C, 160C fan, gas 4, line 12-hole muffin tin with paper cases.
2. Put cup cake ingredients in a large bowl and mix together well. Spoon the mixture into the paper cases, dividing mixture evenly.
3. Bake in oven for 20-25 minutes until well risen and springy to the touch. Remove from the tin and leave to cool on a wire rack.
4. Put frosting ingredients into a bowl and mix until smooth. Either pipe or spread the frosting onto the cooled cakes and dust with cocoa powder.

RECIPE FOR MARMALADE CAKE

Ingredients

225g self raising flour, ¼ level tsp mixed spice, ¼ level tsp cinnamon,
pinch of salt, 110g caster sugar, 3 eggs, 60g glace cherries – halved,
225g mixed fruit, 6 tbsps milk, 110g butter – melted, 1 heaped tbsp
marmalade,
few drops of vanilla extract, 15g chopped walnuts

Method

1. Preheat oven to 150C/300F/Gas 2. Grease and line 15-18cm round tin.
2. Sift flour, spices, salt and sugar into a bowl, add the cherries, mixed fruit and marmalade and mix well.
3. Beat the eggs and stir into the mixture. Add the milk, vanilla extract and melted butter and mix thoroughly.
4. Turn into the prepared cake tin, sprinkle top with the walnuts and bake in centre of oven for 1 hour 50 minutes to 2 hours or until thoroughly cooked.
5. Leave to cool in the tin for 30 minutes then turn out onto a wire rack.
