in sponsoring Classes 1, 2 and 5**

- Class 1** **Welcome to the Celebration – An urn on a pedestal.** An exhibit for a porch or hall. We will supply a 60cm x 60cm square paving slab bedded on sand on the tent floor to ensure a firm base for your exhibit. Floor space allowed 90cms wide x 90cms deep which will be marked out on the ground with the firm base in the centre position. Height optional. Staged against a pale blue background. To be judged from the front. The Claire Louise Memorial Trophy will be presented to the winner of this class.
- Class 2** **Aspects of Rural Life** - An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Brenda Scammell Bronze tazza will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 3** **Inspired by Ikebana** - an exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The William Gamble crystal bowl will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 4** **Surprisingly Square** – an exhibit to be staged using, as your container, a cube of porcelain, wood, earthenware or metal (but not glass). Space allowed 60cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. In honour of our link up with the National Dianthus Society the exhibitor should include some dianthus in this class. The Lewis Cup will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 5** **Winding and Weaving** – an exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Joy Davenport Memorial Cup will be presented to the winner of this class.
- Class 6** **Gothic Fantasy** – an exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional.
- Class 7** **Victoriana** - A petite exhibit. Not to exceed 25cms in width, depth and height. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.

- Class 8** **A decorated napkin ring**
Exhibitor may use fresh or dried/preserved plant material which may be painted or glittered. Bench space allowed 30cms x 30cms. Please include a napkin.
This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.

RULES AND INFORMATION FOR THE FLORAL ART SECTION

Judging will be undertaken by a fully accredited NAFAS Judge in accordance with the Competitor's Manual 3rd Edition 2015 which is available from the National Secretary, NAFAS, Osborne house, 12 Devonshire Square, London EC2M 4TE. A copy will be available in the Floral Art Section on staging day.

Exhibits may be staged on the Saturday of Show weekend from 9.00am to 9.00pm.

All exhibits to be competitor's own work, arranged in the marquee without assistance with the exception of Classes 7 and 8 which may be prepared at home but must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.

The judge's decision is final. Judge Mrs Simone Squire

Prize money will be sent to exhibitors by cheque in the week following the show.

Exhibits not to be dismantled before 4.30pm on Show Day. Exhibitors cards, passes etc needed for Show Day will be given to you on staging day. Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail or letter as soon as received.

Draping will be blue in colour as in previous years. A sample can be made available for new arrangers.

Closing date for entries will be 1st June 2018. Late entries accepted in exceptional circumstances.
