THEME - THE JOY OF FLOWERS

- Class 1 **A World Full of Colour – Floral Art from Around the World** – An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. Please add a title if it is not self explanatory. The Claire Louise Memorial Trophy in memory of Claire Bahi will be presented to the winner of this class.
- Class 2 **Movement** - An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Brenda Scammell Bronze tazza will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 3 **A Basket of Summer Flowers from the Garden** - an exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. In view of our close links with the National Carnation Society we would be pleased if you were able to include some dianthus in the exhibit. The William Gamble Crystal Bowl will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 4 **Circles in your Mind** – an exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Lewis Cup will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 5 **An exhibit in which the container is fashioned from natural plant material.** Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Joy Davenport Memorial Cup will be presented to the winner of this class.
- Class 6 **Petite Perfection** – A petite exhibit. Not to exceed 25cms in width, depth and height. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.

CRAFT CLASS

- Class 7 **Carnival Time** - An exhibit in the form of a Afro Caribbean headdress. A preformed head for staging will be provided to those who require one. This exhibit can be any plant material, fresh or dried or a mixture of both and can contain dried pulses/glitter/feathers. Plant material must predominate. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging. A crystal vase donated by Linda Hayes will be presented to the winner of this class.

RULES AND INFORMATION FOR THE FLORAL ART SECTION

Judging will be undertaken by a fully accredited NAFAS Judge in accordance with the Competitor's Manual 3rd Edition 2015 which is available from the National Secretary, NAFAS, Osborne house, 12 Devonshire Square, London EC2M 4TE. A copy will be available in the Floral Art Section on staging day.

Exhibits may be staged on the Saturday of Show weekend from 9.00am to dusk. Friday arranging could be available for those who find Saturday arranging difficult.

Exhibits may be brought part completed or greened but must be finished in the marquee with the exception of classes 6 and 7 which may be completed at home.

In Class 3 we would request that exhibitors use garden flowers – not necessarily from the exhibitor's own garden.

The judge's decision is final. Judge Mrs Jane Walden of Keyworth.

Prize money will be sent to exhibitors by cheque in the week following the show.

Exhibits not to be dismantled before 4.30pm on Show Day. Exhibitors cards, passes etc needed for Show Day will be sent out by post before staging day. Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail or letter as soon as received.

In 2019 all classes will be on front facing tabling in straight runs and judged from the front. Draping will be blue in colour as in previous years. A sample of draping can be made available for new arrangers.

Closing date for entries will be 1st June 2019. Late entries accepted in exceptional circumstances.

AWARDS

Prize money Classes 1 – 7 1st £20, 2nd £15, 3rd £10,

The Brenda Scammell Memorial Rose Bowl presented by the Eagle Centre Market Traders will be awarded to the Best Exhibit in the Show from Classes 1 – 6.

The Harold and Joy Davenport Memorial Tray will be awarded to the Runner up to the Best in Show from Classes 1 – 6.

The Brian and Carol Suter Trophy will be presented to the exhibit which demonstrates the best use of colour.

The Ann Cup will be given to the exhibit which best retains its freshness at the time of prize giving (4.00pm on Show Day)
